## **Ridership Overview**

#### November 2017

System-wide ridership was down 2.7% compared to November 2016. Average weekday was also down 2.7%. There were the same number of weekdays compared to last November. Fuel prices continue inching up.

The Board passed the proposed service changes for June 2018 which includes many of the recommendations from Connections 2025. The new services include additional high frequency routes, more direct routing and better connections.

#### **Fixed Route & MetroRapid**

Total month Fixed Route ridership was down 7.9% from November 2016. Average weekday was down 7.5%. Since the fare reduction on Rapid, riders have been moving over to that service.

MetroRapid saw an increase of 53.2% from November 2016. Average weekday was up 46.2%. This increase is related to the fare reduction, eliminating the Premium fare with riders moving over from other services operating in the same corridor. Enhanced frequency also added to the MetroRapid increase in November.

Looking at Fixed Route and MetroRapid bus services combined ridership was only down 1.2% from November 2016.

#### **Round Rock**

As a part of Fixed Route service, Capital Metro began providing service to the City of Round Rock in August 2017. For the third full month of service in November, there were over 4,600 boardings. This slight reduction from October is typical as the holiday season begins in November.

#### **Georgetown**

For the new fixed route service in Georgetown in November, there were 1,324 boardings.

#### **MetroAccess**

MetroAccess showed an increase for November 2017 and was up 4.3% compared to last year. MetroAccess continues with efforts to manage this high cost service through eligibility evaluations, travel training, and pathway assessment.

#### **UT Shuttle**

For November 2017, UT Shuttle showed a 15.4% decrease from last November. UT Shuttle did not operate the day before Thanksgiving, one day less than last year. Capital Metro continues to evaluate UT Shuttle service and potential strategies for increasing ridership.

#### **RideShare**

The vRide program is going strong and showed a 9.3% increase for November.

#### <u>MetroRail</u>

MetroRail ridership was up 5.2% from November 2016 and average weekday ridership was up 4.6% from the same period. MetroRail is at capacity during peak periods and this service has maintained steady ridership levels over the past year. Upgrades to this service will come in January 2018.
