



Participate in the Green Line Virtual Open House Survey

Capital Metro is currently working on a Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) Study for the Green Line to plan for future growth in Northeast Austin in a way that allows people to walk to more locations and use transit as part of their daily life. The MetroRapid, Blue Line, and Orange Line VOHs are now closed and the results are in! Thank you for all your feedback on the proposed corridors. With your input, we are one step closer to a better Austin transit system!

Overall Results

- The majority of respondents preferred the creation of both the dedicated transitway option over both the MetroRapid improvement option and the Do Nothing option.
- Most respondents indicated an interest in the addition of a downtown transit tunnel.

MetroRapid

- We heard from over 2,000 people across 33 zip codes and received over 750 comments on the proposed expansion of MetroRapid bus service.
- There was a large interest in expanding service and spacing station locations for greater connectivity.
- Support for increasing service frequency and additional transfer points to improve accessibility.
- Support for Project Connect amenities like park and ride lots, neighborhood circulators and bicycle accommodations.
- We also received 41 comments expressing an interest in dedicated lanes.

Blue Line Corridor:

- Slightly more respondents preferred a crossing of Lady Bird Lake at Trinity Street over a crossing at S. 1st Street.
- More respondents preferred a Light Rail Transit (LRT) option than a Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) option, with approximately 28% of respondents indicating "either LRT or BRT" as their preference.

Orange Line

- The majority of respondents preferred a Light Rail Transit (LRT) option over a Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) option, with approximately 25% of respondents indicating "either LRT or BRT" as their preference.
